



GRANT RECIPIENTS SHARE IN \$150,000+

The Veolia Mulwaree Trust congratulates the latest recipients of funding from its community grant program. A variety of local groups and organisations have shared in more than \$150,000 distributed at the Trust's recent meeting.

Marulan's Mad Bulls Cricket Club has received \$14,941 for the refurbishment of their ground in Brayton Road including installing a new turf wicket for seniors and synthetic wicket for junior cricket.

The **Marulan Rural Fire Brigade** has received \$16,000 to extend the kitchen area and create a lockup storage area at its fire shed.

The **Crookwell Branch of the CWA** has received \$6,742 for a new kitchen at the CWA rooms in Spring Street.

\$10,148 was granted to the **Middle Arm/Wayo Rural Fire Brigade** toward the cost of construction of toilet facilities at the brigade's shed.

Braidwood Central School received \$35,000 toward the purchase of a new 30-seat bus for the school.

The **Goulburn Mulwaree Little Athletics Club** received \$8154 toward the construction of two discus cages at Hudson Park in Bradfordville which will assist both the club and local schools during their annual athletics carnivals.

The **Crookwell District Hospital** received \$11,910 toward the purchase of a new activity bus for clients.

The **Braidwood Hospital Auxiliary** received \$23,000 toward the erection of a vergola as part of a beautification project at Narbethong House frail aged care facility.

The **Windellama Progress Association** has received \$3429 toward the purchase of three shade tents for the use at Windellama community events.

The **Taralga Pony Club** received \$9509 toward building a new clubhouse and the installation of a water tank at the Taralga Showground, providing a secure facility to centralise and store equipment and records.

Goulburn Branch of the Riding for the Disabled will receive eight new purpose-built saddles for participants with a Trust grant of \$13,559.

A donation of \$1000 was made to the **Goulburn Rainbow Club** to support its program of providing specialised swimming programs to local disabled children.

The **Goulburn Teapot Club** received a donation of \$1000 to assist in its support of the **Southern Tablelands Autism Support Group**.

A donation of \$3000 was made to **Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation**.
